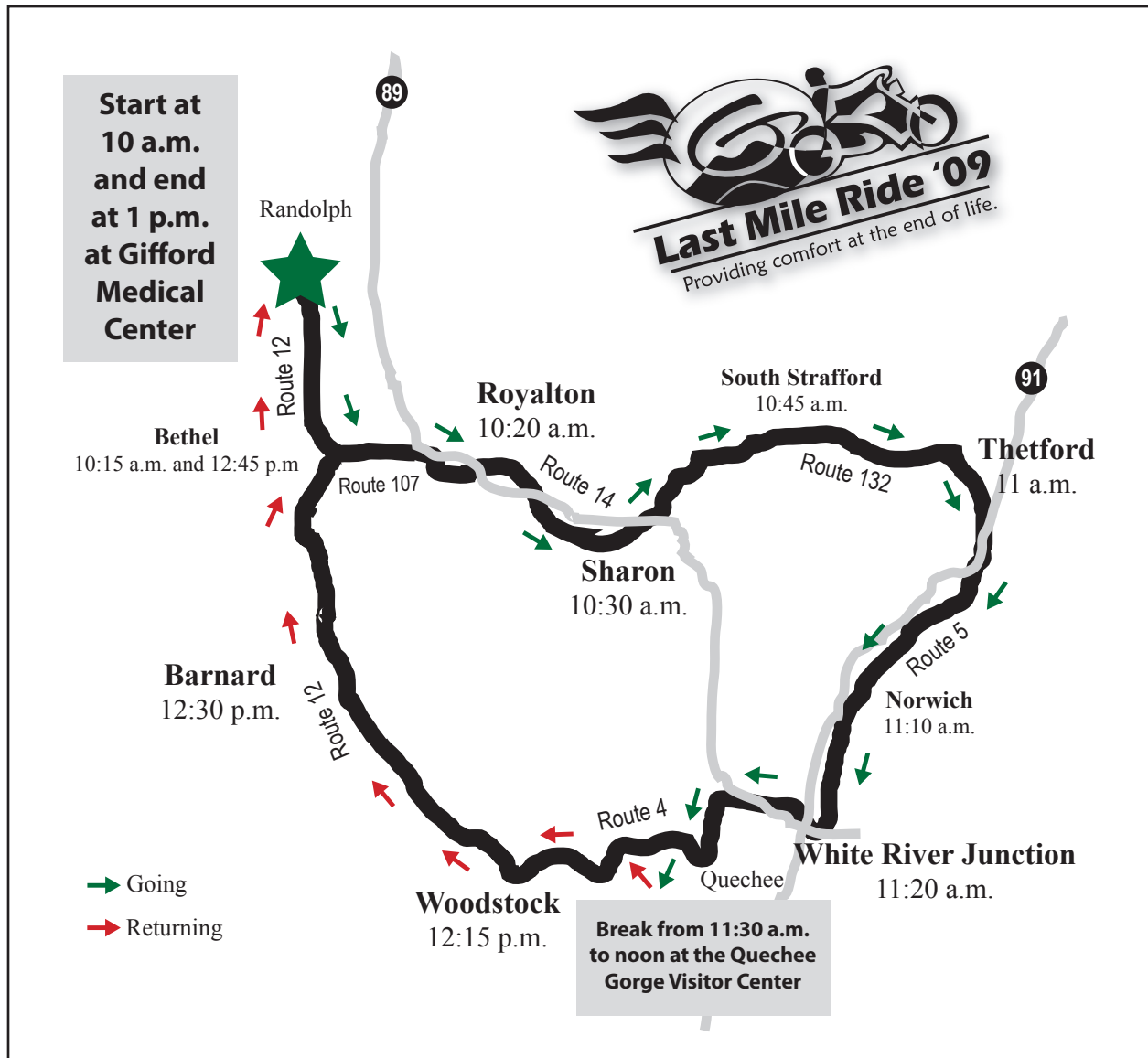


The Last Mile Ride route

Community members are warmly invited to help cheer on the Last Mile riders on Saturday, Aug. 15. The Last Mile Ride supports end-of-life care at Gifford Medical Center in Randolph. The ride will pass through the communities shown on the map below. Times included are *approximate*. Your support is appreciated!



Details: The Last Mile Ride starts at Gifford in Randolph at 10 a.m. and heads out of town south on Route 12. Riders will follow Route 12 to Route 107 in Bethel and then Route 14 in Royalton. The riders will then take Route 132 to South Strafford and Thetford, turning south on Route 5 and heading toward White River Junction. In White River Junction, they'll take Route 4 to Quechee, where they will break for about 30 minutes at the Quechee Gorge Visitor Center, overlooking the picturesque Quechee Gorge. (A Mobile and a Citgo are on Route 4 exactly 2.5 miles before the visitor center and a Shell station is also just .1 miles after the center for those who need to gas up.) The ride resumes on Route 4 to Woodstock and then takes a right onto Route 12 north, heading back toward Bethel and Gifford in Randolph, where a barbecue lunch, massages and live music await the riders.
